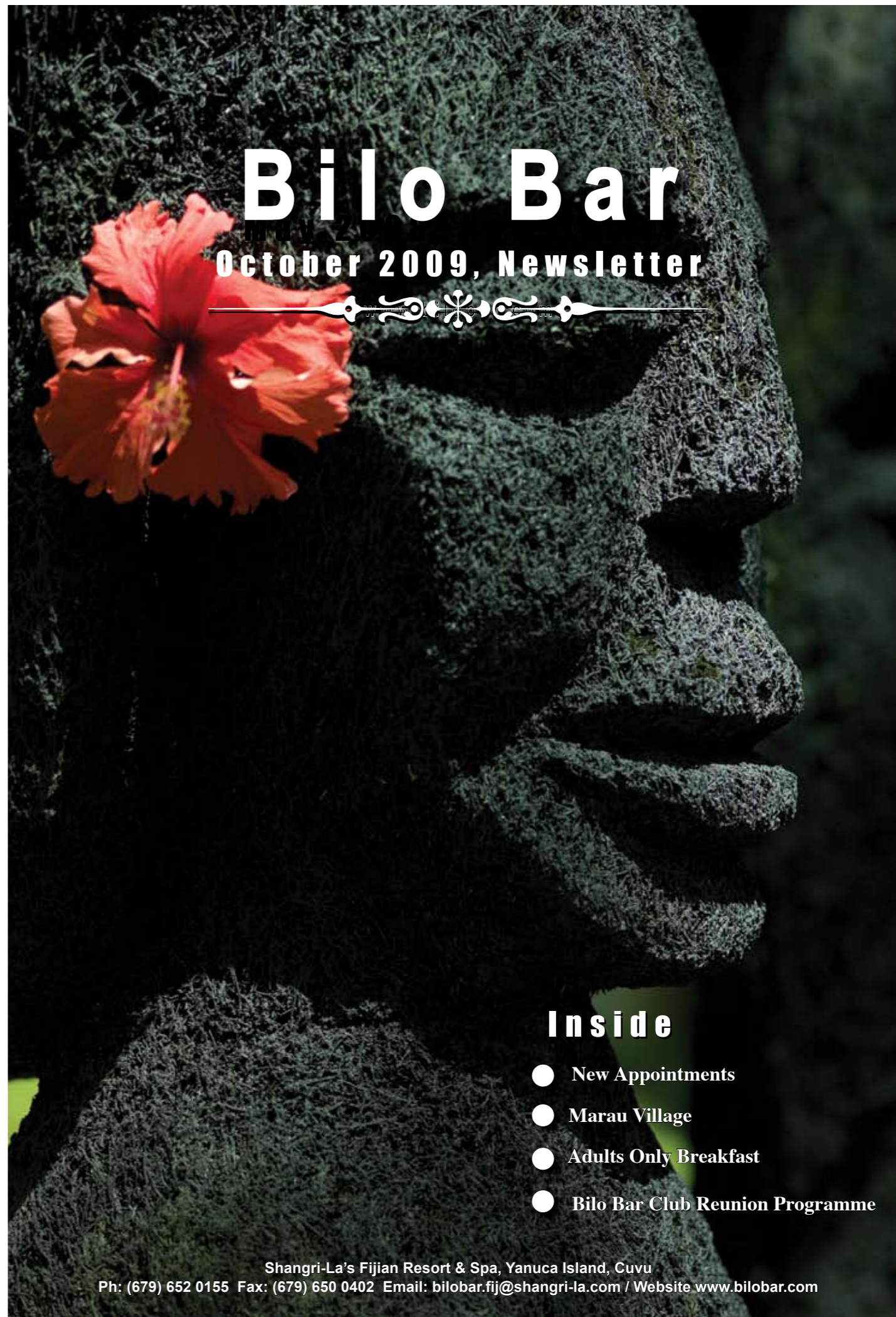

## Marau Village

The re-vamped Village site at Shangri-La's Fijian Resort and Spa, *Marau Village*, was officially opened by the paramount chief of the Nadroga Navosa province, the Kalevu, Ratu Sakiusa Makutu, on 28 August. The area can sit over 400 people and is the venue for the Resort's firewalking and meke shows by the Beqa firewalkers and well known Laselase meke group.

The Marau Village was renovated over a three-month period with traditional elements such as thatch roofs, magi magi (coconut sinnet) and slabs of vesi, a hard wood endemic to Fiji, at the buffet stations. Baka vine and waqiri vines also feature at the Marau village with a beautiful piece of Baka vine rescued from a sawmill in Lautoka. Resort General Manager, Daniele Vastolo, said that the revamp of the Village was an opportunity to showcase and further enhance the cultural experience for visitors. "We hold weekly shows and we wanted to look at ways of presenting a cultural experience that is embodied in the design, performance and culinary side of our Fijian show," Mr Vastolo said.
