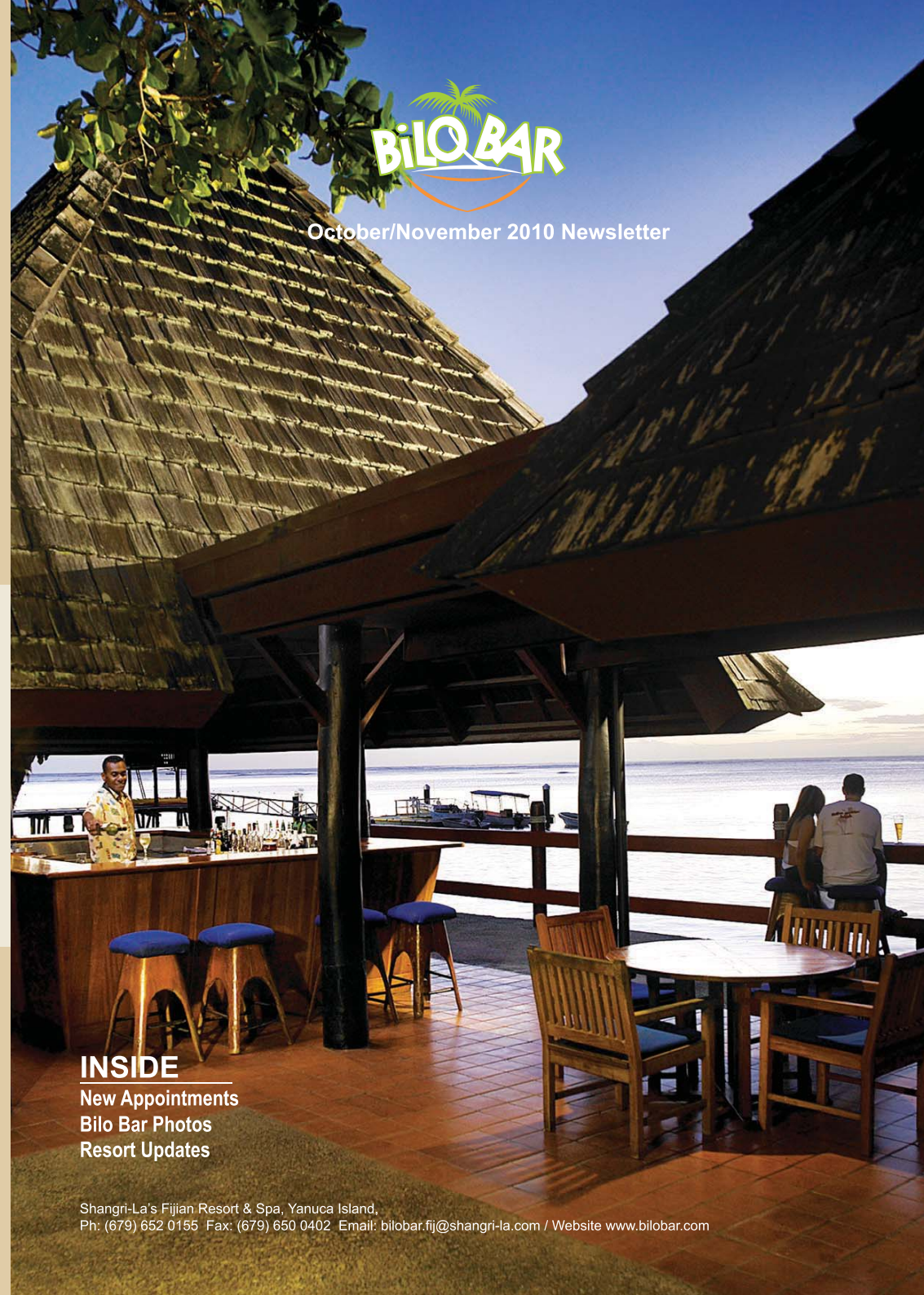

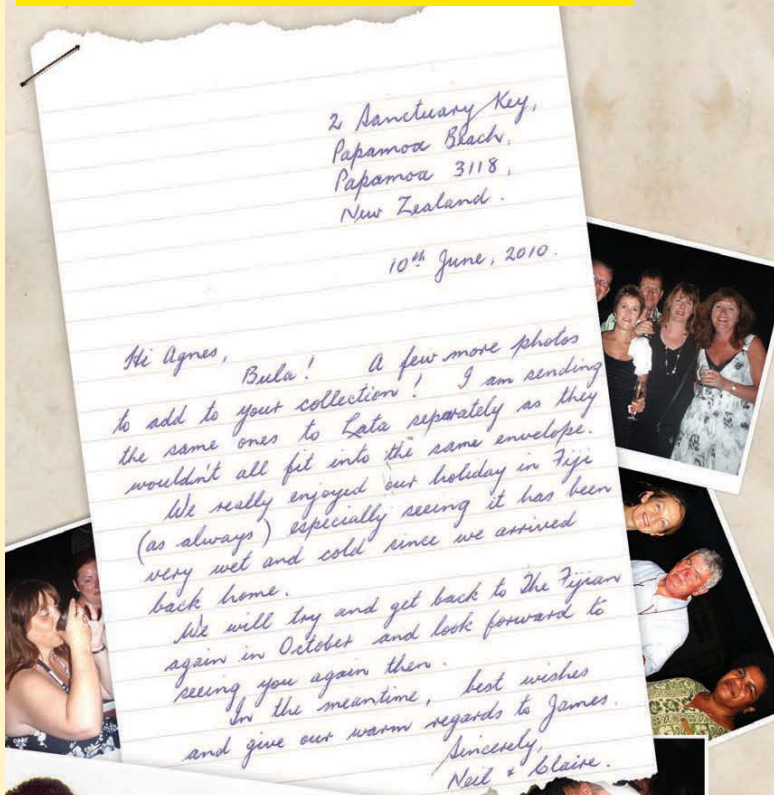

Bilo Bar History

In 1980, five Australians were having a drink at the Bilo Bar, a practice not uncommon to them during their many visits to the then Fijian Resort.

The manager of the Resort at the time, Al Wymann, joined them and during the course of their conversation, the five said they thought it was time their regular visits were acknowledged in some way. The Manager thought that there was some merit in this. Several drinks later, all agreed the best thing to do was to form a club and what better name than the Bilo Bar Club, keeping in mind all the meetings seemed to be held here. Mr Wymann thought about it and several months later, at a dinner in Sydney, involving the same people, the new baby was born.

Then in May 1981, the paramount Chief the Kalevu Emanuel Vosailagi became the Club's life patron.

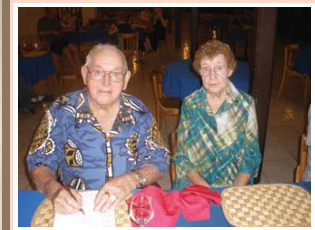
The Bilo Bar Club was formalised by the issuing of Articles of Association in May 1981. Mr Wymann received the equally important sounding title of Grand Bilo as the activities of this new club were to be conducted on the Resort. Furthermore, keeping in mind his tenure in Fiji was limited, it was declared the title of Grand Bilo would be bestowed on subsequent general managers.

While the club was initially a social gathering it became much more when a cyclone devastated the area and visiting members found themselves talking to employees who had become their friends and who had lost everything during the cyclone. In what can only be described as a typical desire of return guests to help someone disadvantaged, the hat went around. A considerable sum was raised and the Bilo Bar Club was changed forever.

As a result of this, the Bilo Bar Club Trust Fund was created in 1988 to be administered by three trustees one of whom is the Resort's General Manager. The constitution covering this fund was altered somewhat in 1998 to increase, to a small degree, the range of options available for expenditure by the Trustees and to hold elections for the Club's officers.

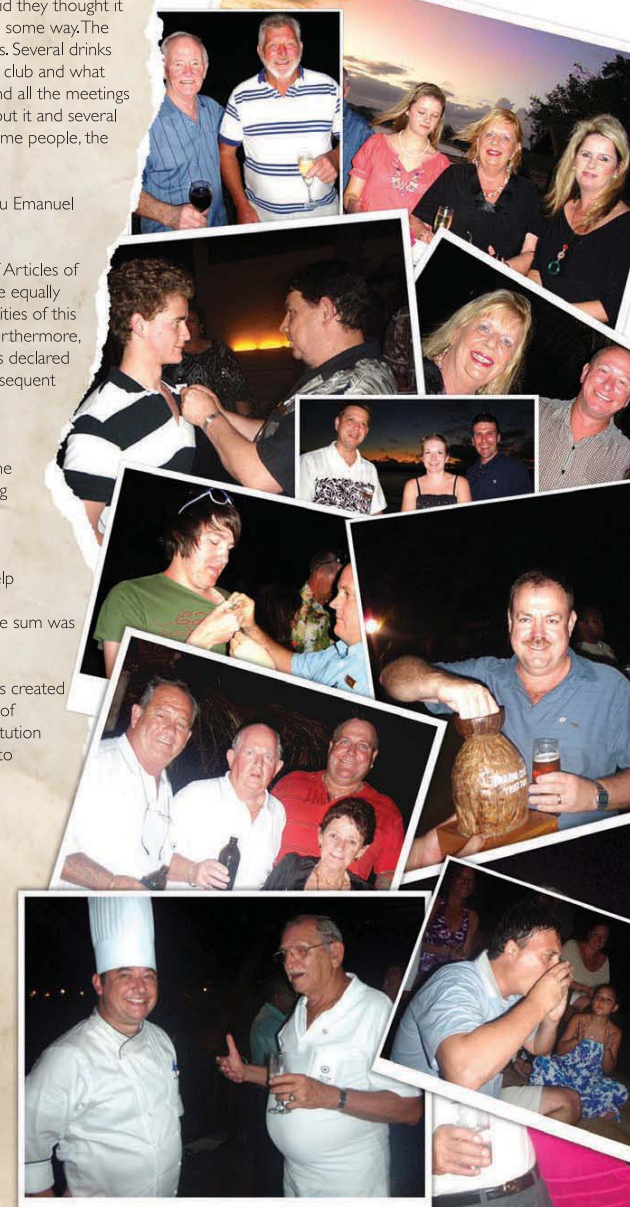
Building commenced immediately and today our kindergartens are considered to be amongst the best in the country. The BBC has also been actively involved in raising over \$40,000 for the Sigatoka Hospital since 1997 and to this day continues to support community activities throughout the District of Cuvu.
